Welcome back to school everyone for the second half of the Autumn term. The children have been excellent this week and have come back into school ready to learn. Our youngest children have been exploring shape and positional language (such as behind, under and so on) in maths and have enjoyed putting this to practical use around school and outdoors.

Mrs Stiansen has been very happy with Class 2 in English taking part in drama / role play - which has helped the children to prepare to write in role as April from our class book, 'The Last Bear' by Hannah Gold. Their writing has been so impressive and shows how well they understand the complexity of Hannah's relationship with her father and Bear. They are also exploring how figurative language can enhance their writing.

Everyone took part in an art afternoon exploring cave paintings linked to our overall learning theme of Stone Age to Iron Age. This was a chance to think about what it would be like to create artwork showing movement on vertical surfaces or drawing on cave ceilings.

Dates for your diary


