Spellings

- Year 1** Adding the ending 'er' to adjectives where no change is needed to the root word
Eg grander, fresher, quicker
- Year 2** Adding 'er' to a root word ending in 'y' with a consonant before it. The 'y' is changed to 'i' before 'er'
Eg sillier, funnier, happier
- Year 3** Doubling consonant when vowel is before consonant 'er', 'en'
Eg forgotten, beginner
- Year 4** Contractions-Questions
Eg who is - who's where will- where'll
