# **Curriculum update**

The history part of the topic will be looking at how war affected people living in Northumberland and the North East. This theme continues after the Easter holidays for the next half term. After that we will be changing to the theme of the environment and looking after the natural world.

Most prefixes are added to the beginning of words without any change in spelling. 'In' can mean 'not'

or 'in/into

Eg inactive, incorrect, indecisive

Year 4 Plurals - RULE #4

If words end in 'f' or 'fe' then get rid of the 'f' and

add 'ves'

Eg half = halves, leaf = leaves, knife = knives,

wolf = wolves
