This week we have begun a new topic in RE - Incarnation. The children have been thinking about the nativity story in Luke's gospel and how this can be shown in different ways through art from around the world. They have also enjoyed programming in computing. The younger children are working with a Beebot and making mats for them to follow and the older children are using Scratch to program games. This has required some persistence on their part as 'debugging' is an essential part of the process.

Our year 5s took part in a Hockey festival this week alongside other Berwick primary schools at Longridge Towers. This was a really well organised morning and the children had the chance to play games as well as learn skills alongside new friends. Mrs Stiansen and Mrs Walton were really pleased with how our children did at the event - well done!

The younger children have been busy learning about time - telling the time as well as thinking about days of the week, months and seasons. They have also been finding out what they can do in 1 minute! Class 2 have been fantastic learning about electricity and making circuits in science.
