A great big welcome back to everyone for our last half term of the year. This week the children have been considering the Sikh practice of langar to help feed the hungry and look after everyone in the community. In history we have been myth busting some common misconceptions about the Vikings and thinking about what Viking people were and owned depending on their role in society.

A highlight of our week has been the school trip to Countryside Day on Thursday. The children enjoyed a good range of activities and stalls throughout the day. They particularly enjoyed the sheep show with dancing sheep and sheep shearing. Some of the children had a go in the auction stand although they weren't quite tall enough! There was an excellent forestry section where they learned about how trees are cut down, stripped and chipped as well as what tree surgeons do. They had fun at the Bedmax stall, learning about how every part of the tree is used. Other favourites were the bee keepers with the free honey samples, the samples of venison sausages and planting trees with Cheviot Trees.
