



Adding the suffixes (ing) (ed) and (er) when the root word doesn't need to be changed.

This happens when the root word ends in two consonants.

	Adding 'ing'
	jump → jump <mark>ing</mark>
	help \rightarrow helping
2	m buzz \rightarrow buzzing
	hunt \rightarrow hunting

Adding 'ed' $jump \rightarrow jumped$ $help \rightarrow helped$ $buzz \rightarrow buzzed$ $hunt \rightarrow hunted$

Adding 'er' $jump \rightarrow jumper$ help \rightarrow helper $buzz \rightarrow buzzer$ hunt \rightarrow hunter





Adding the suffixes er and est to adjectives when the root word doesn't need to be changed.

This happens when the root word ends in two consonants.
