Year 1 Plurals—adding 'es' to words

Eg catches, matches, witches, watches

Year 2 Adding 'es' to nouns and verbs ending in 'y'.
The 'y' is changed to 'i' before 'es' is added

Eg flies, tries, replies, copies, babies, carries

Year 3 Suffix exceptions. If the root word ends with

'le' the 'le' is changed to 'ly'

Eg gently, simply, humbly, nobly

Year 4 The suffix 'ous' rule 4

If there is an 'i' sound, before the 'ous' it is usually spelt as 'i' but some words have 'e'

Eg serious, obvious,

hideous, spontaneous
