We kicked off the week with a fantastic trip to the Centre for Life in Newcastle. The children have been telling me about what they did and what they saw all week. Highlights were the ice skating, the space zone and the planetarium. They have been inspired to produce some great written work describing their visit and the older children have been considering whether the activities on offer constitute 'value for money'.







We have linked in our art work this week to Starry Night by Vincent Van Gogh. This has inspired some mixed media work using pencil, paint and oil pastels. The children have worked beautifully to create some very impressive night skies.

Active lunchtimes have been fun too. The children have had a javelin throwing challenge where they had to try to throw the foam 'javelins' through circles. They also had a hockey challenge testing their agility and accuracy, manoeuvring around cones and scoring goals. We look forward to more active challenges in the following lunchtimes.

Next Friday (31st January) we will be spending the day on Holy Island (returning to Lowick before the end of the school day). The day has an RE theme and the children will need a packed lunch (or a grab and go from Margaret). They will also need appropriate outdoor clothing to keep warm and/or dry as we plan to be outdoors in the afternoon.

The visit includes nursery children who will do their own versions of our activities and hopefully enjoy the Holy Island school environment. The causeway is open during the day if nursery parents want to pick up their children at the end of the morning or lunchtime.

Eg loudest, slowest, quietest

Year 2 The last consonant letter of the root word is

doubled to keep the a, e, i, o, u sound (short

vowel – eg 'a' as in ant).

Exception: The letter 'x' is never doubled:

mixing, mixed, boxer, sixes.

Eg patting, patted; humming, hummed dropping, dropped; sadder, saddest

aropping, aroppea, sadder, sad

fatter, fattest; runner, runny

Year 3 More suffix 'ous'

In these words, 'our' is changed to 'or' before

'ous' is added

Eg humour, humorous; glamour, glamorous,

Vigour, vigorous

Year 4 Contractions 2—Demonstratives

Eg there will - there'll; there is - there's
