Curriculum themes for next term

Next term, we will be finding out about the beginning of the Kingdom of England. The children will be learning about early kingdoms and how they came together to become England in Anglo Saxon times. We will be looking in depth at the life of King Alfred the Great as well as the accomplishments of his grandson King Athelstan.

We are also planning an enrichment week which will include support for the spiritual, mental, social and cultural development of our children. This will include skipping workshops, a forest school visit to Branton (who have an amazing outdoor set up next to the nature reserve there), work with the Lindisfarne National Nature Reserve about pollinators and a visit from Mark, the Bishop of Berwick, to lead our **Pentecost service at Lowick church** (on **Thursday 16th May - please join us at 1.30pm**). He came on our pilgrimage walk across the sands last year and we are delighted he is now able to come and visit our Lowick school site, share lunch with us and lead the procession from the school to the church.
