We have had an exciting week in school this week. We have been thinking scientifically in our science lessons and the years 3 & 4s were investigating the reproductive parts of flowering plants whilst year 5 were putting in the leg work to recreate a model of the solar system across our school grounds.















Our science learning about plants with links to the Stone Age to Iron Age were reinforced with a great trip to the Hirsel in Coldstream for a 'field to fork' interactive day. The children were able to explore the crops and identify which ones were available in Stone Age to Iron Age times and which ones are more modern. They also had a cooking workshop to make oat cakes and butter. A really interesting day - we were also very grateful for the beautiful sunshine as we were outside a lot of the day.
