Class 1 have been doing some lovely work in English this week. They are enjoying their class book 'Alan's Big Scary Teeth' and have been inspired to write their own stories and make wanted posters. They also have been building on their visit to Duddo Stones last week by practising using compass directions in geography, using map symbols and designing their own map symbol for a stone circle.









Meanwhile, our years 3 & 4s were excited to see the results from our weeks long experiment to see if a plant can survive in the freezer. We had three plants so we have had a control plant in a light and warm room, another in a dark but warm room and finally one in the freezer (a dark and very cold environment) for several weeks. The children have done detailed drawings of each of the plants to show the effects these different environments have had on them. Our next step is to let the three plants be in a light and warm environment over half term to see how they get on and the children will be writing up their findings in science.









Remembrance after half term

This year for Remembrance we have invited Tim Cryar into school to talk to the children about Remembrance from the perspective of the navy. We will be joining with the village and Rev Alex for a remembrance service at the War Memorial in Lowick at 10.45am on 11th November. You are welcome to join us and everyone is invited back to school afterwards for refreshments and to warm up!



We have poppies and other items for donation on behalf of the Poppy Fund available in school (as we usually do each year).

Our year 5s demonstrated their leadership skills when they joined in with 70 children from other schools in Berwick to take part in School Games' SSOC (School Sports Organisation Crew) training. The training was for our year 5s to be leaders helping to organise games on our yard to help the children to be active at playtimes. They learnt a range of games as well as how to adapt them for younger or older children. The children enjoyed their training and have already planned and delivered games and activities for lunchtime today with a Halloween theme!
