We want to support you in helping your children at home and we welcome any requests from parents for further workshops. We also ask that you listen to your children read regularly and fill in their yellow reading records. Other homework will be set as appropriate and according to need. A lot of our children are pretty tired at the end of the day at the moment (getting used to the new school routine takes a bit of time) and we know that they need a chance to relax and play after school.
